COVID-19 STATEMENT FROM BELMOND BRITISH PULLMAN

"We continue to operate within the guidelines of the Government and will adapt any processes within these guidelines. All details of how Belmond have responded can be found here.

For the Belmond British Pullman in particular, we have implemented the following changes to ensure a safe environment for both our clients and our staff:

- reduced seating capacity to allow for social distancing on board
- all guests to receive a wellness form 48 hours prior

to travel to confirm fitness to travel

- all guests to have a temperature check prior to boarding
- all guests to wear masks on boarding and when moving through the train
- staff to wear masks at all times
- food service changed from silver service to plated to limit movement through the train
- hand sanitiser on boarding and in all bathrooms."

THE CARRIAGES

Honouring George Mortimer Pullman, the father of luxury train travel, the Pullman carriages are the height of train luxury. Each is individually named with a unique story to tell.

Some have been used extensively by the British royal family. Others have carried luminaries including President de Gaulle and Nikita Khrushchev. Two were part of Winston Churchill's funeral train.

The Transylvanian Express will include ten carriages chosen from the following: Ione, Ibis, Gwen, Vera, Audrey, Lucille, Zena, Cygnus, Perseus, Minerva and Phoenix. Each has its own character and history.
