#### Second Lockdown & Markets

Sevenoaks Town Council has received the following advice from NMTF (National Markets Trader Federation) and NABMA (National Association of British Market Authorities).

In England new national restrictions come into force on Thursday, 5 November - Lockdown 2. Under these restrictions, indoor and outdoor markets can remain open for the sale of essential goods only.

- **Food and grocery**
- **Household goods**
- **Hardware supplies**
- **Bicycles**
- **Pet supplies**
- **Newsagents**
- Flowers and plants
